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1. はじめに / Introduction

第10回日中韓大学院生フォーラム(10th Japan-China-Korea Graduate Student Forum 2017)が、2017年9月22日から25日まで中国、北京市の中国地質大学(China University of Geosciences)国際交流センターで開催されました。日本からは筑波大学、東北大学、北海道大学、神戸大学、中国からは北京大学、清華大学、中国地質大学、中国農業大学、中国科学地理院、中国科学院研究生院、瀋陽農業大学、韓国からは忠南大学、日中韓3カ国から計12校の参加がありました。筑波大学から大学院生29名、学類生1名、教職員8名が参加しました。

このフォーラムは、大学院生主体で国際会議の運営を行い、プレゼンテーション技術を向上させ、国際交流と国際理解を図ることを目的としています。今回は、中国地質大学の大学院生が運営主体となり、**Life**、**Environment**、**Resources**の3つの分野、12セッションで、学生による124題の口頭発表が行われました。

9月24日の夜に行われた授賞式では、筑波大学から1等賞6名、2等賞6名、3等賞6名が受賞しました。筑波大学生の研究水準、英語でのプレゼンテーションスキルの高さを示す結果となりました。同時に行われたフェアウェルパーティーでは、各大学からパフォーマンスが披露されました。筑波大学からは全員が参加して、日本伝統のソーラン節を披露し、そのパワーで会場を多めに盛り上げました。

中国地質大学関係者の心のもった歓迎と運営、そして美味しい中国料理のおかげで、終始和気あいあいの雰囲気の中で、学生同士、教員同士、スタッフ同士の交流が盛んに行われ、実りの多いフォーラムとなりました。9月24日午後開催されたラウンドテーブル会議では、次の10年間の日中韓大学院生フォーラムの開催方針について議論され、本フォーラムの継続と更なるレベルアップを目指すことで意見が一致しました。また、来年、2018年の第11回日中韓大学院生フォーラムは、9月27日～30日に筑波大学で開催されることが決定されました。

今回の日中韓大学院生フォーラムで筑波大生が大きな成果を上げたのは、学生リーダーの見事なリーダーシップと素晴らしいチームワークの賜物です。また、生命環境支援室中国サポートチーム、国際連携、WEB担当の皆様の尽力で今回のフォーラムの事務業務がスムーズに進められました。そして特筆すべきことは、本学の学生たちが優秀な成績を収めることができたのは、発表練習会で指導をして下さった先生方の適切な指導と厳しい訓練の成果だと思えます。ご協力いただいた教員各位に心からお礼を申し上げます。

2. フォーラムの略歴

- 2007年3月 北京大学、清華大学、中国地質大学、中国農業大学、北京師範大学、中国科学院大学院(GUCAS)、Institute of Geographic Sciences and Natural Resources Research (CAS)の6大学1研究所と筑波大学の間で、学生交流を含む大学間協定が交わされた。この協定が契機となって、その後の日中の大学間で交流が開始した。
- 6月 GUCASの副学長の筑波大学訪問時に、大学院生のフォーラムに関する構想が提案される。
- 8月 先の構想をもとに本格的なフォーラムの企画が開始される。当初のねらいは日中間の相互理解と学問的な情報共有にあった。規模が拡大した現在でも Academic な交流としての側面と、学生同士の交流の場としての側面として、この精神は受け継がれている。ここで二国間の持ち回り開催などの基本的枠組みが決定された。

2. History of the forum

Institute of Geographic Sciences and Natural Resources Research (CAS) set an agreement including student exchange.
- June 2007 Vice-president of GUCAS visited UT. At that time outline of the forum was fixed.
- August 2007 President of CUGB visited UT to discuss actual plan of the forum. Initial aim was mutual understanding and exchange academic information among universities. It was decided here to have the first forum in UT, and second one in CUGB.
- March 2008 Pre-forum was held in Beijing.
- October 2008 The first forum was held in UT.

1) 学生リーダーからの報告 / Report from Student Leaders

本フォーラムの学生リーダーは、昨年第 9 回フォーラムのリーダーを経験している大学院生 3 名で組織された。

ここでは、学生リーダーの仕事内容の一部とフォーラムの改善事項について述べる。

○参加者募集及び参加者への連絡

参加者募集のため、5 月中旬にポスターを生命環境系の各研究棟に掲示した。応募者のアブストラクトと英語能力をもとに複数名の先生に選考を行っていただき、参加者を決定した。参加者には Google グループのメーリングリストを用いて連絡を行った。また、グループ LINE を併用することで、参加者が質問しやすい環境を形成した。

○練習会の開催

英語での口頭発表能力の向上、スライドのデザインや発表内容の構成などを含めたプレゼンテーション能力の向上を目的として、例年事前練習会を行っている。練習会への参加回数 2 回を義務付けた。講師陣は本フォーラムの実行委員の先生(沼田先生、荒川先生、楊先生、康先生、Wood 先生、浅野先生、Marcos 先生、上野先生、久田先生)にお願ひし、英語での発表の仕方やスライドの作り方等を指導して頂いた。結果として、筑波大生は練習会の時より、質の高い発表ができていたと思われる。

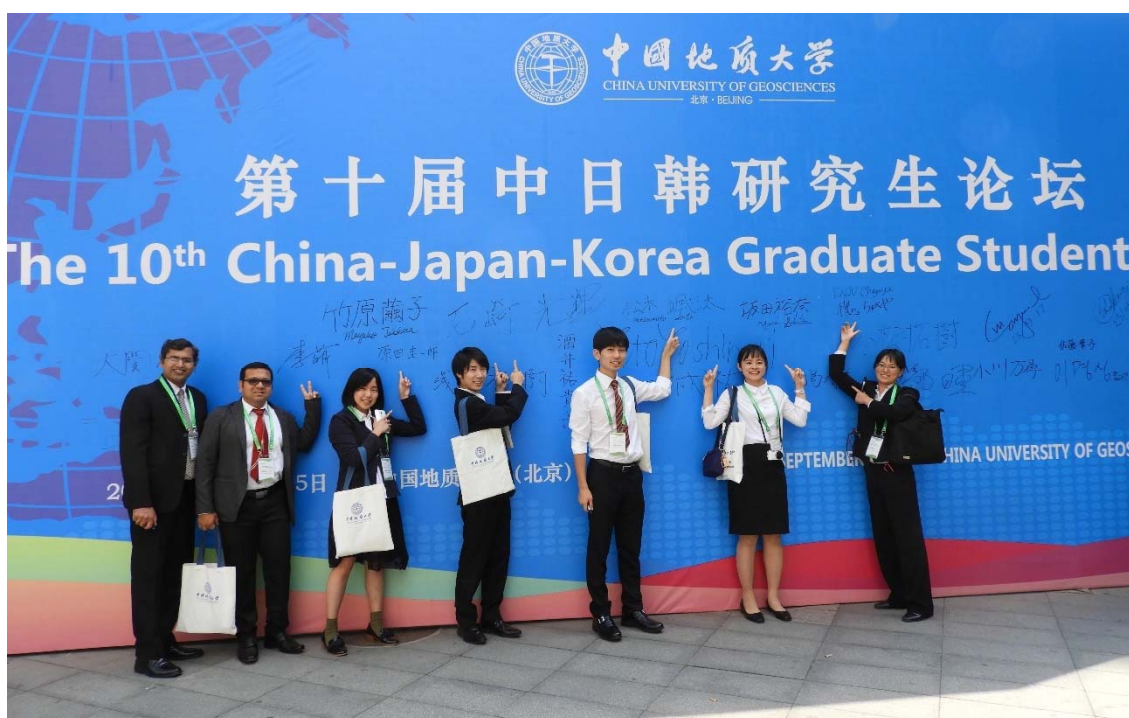
○フォーラムの改善事項

準備段階においては、留学生のビザ申請でいくつかの問題が発生した。学生リーダーにビザ申請のノウハウが全くなかったため、留学生たちの質問にうまく対応することができなかった。結果的に 5 名ほどの留学生はビザ関連の問題で本フォーラムに同行することができなかった。ビザについては、日本人の学生リーダーが対応することは困難であると思われる。また、練習会の形式について、先生から苦情が出たこともあった。先生の負担を軽減するため、よりよい練習会の形式を考える必要がある。

フォーラム中のトラブルとしては、発表への評価を担当する教授陣への不満が散見した。発表者のやる気や次年度の参加者の集まり具合に影響を及ぼす可能性があるため、担当する先生には事前のお願いはもちろん、直前にも連絡し、担当の時間は確実に開けてもらえるよう、念を押す必要があるかもしれない。

Fun when it comes to seeing a new culture: delicious food, fun people, traditional dances and singing and the Chinese hospitality is remarkable and very nice monuments.

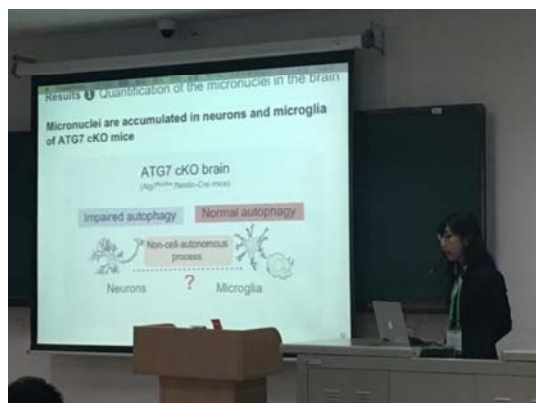

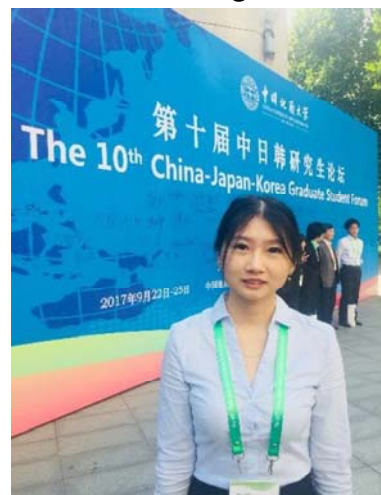

平成29年9月22日から25日にかけて、中国北京、中国地質大学（China University of Geosciences）の中国地質大学国際交流センターで、第10回日中韓大学院生フォーラム（10th China-Japan-Korea Graduate Student Forum 2017）が開催された。日本からの参加大学は、筑波大学、東北大学、北海道大学、神戸大学、中国からは北京大学、清華大学、中国地質大学、中国農業大学、中国科学地理院、中国科学院研究生院、瀋陽農業大学、韓国からは忠南大学、日中韓三か国から計12校の参加があり、筑波大学からは、大学院生29名、学類生1名、教職員8名が派遣された。

このフォーラムは、地球、生物、生物資源専門分野を超えた大学、大学院生が、学生主体で国際会議の運営を行い、プレゼンテーション技術を向上させ、国際交流と国際理解を図ることを目的とするフォーラムである。今回は、中国地質大学の大学院（Graduate School, China University of Geosciences）の大学院生が運営主体となってフォーラムが実施され、Life、Environment、Resources 三つのセッションを振り分け、各会場で二日間にわたり行われた。フォーラム全体では、中国地質大学と福島大学の教授による2件のキーノートスピーチ、学生による124件の口頭発表が行われた。

- ・事務的な調整や処理を担い、参加学生に発表や交流の準備・実行に集中してもらう
- ・学生委員が参加学生に対しリーダーシップを発揮できるよう支援する

2 活動と所感

今回、チームメンバーで下記の役割を設定してサポートを行いました。

2.1 大学院共通科目の単位認定・記念品の手配（水代 祐子）

大学院共通科目の単位認定を希望する参加者について、フォーラムの事前練習会への参加状況を確認してリストを作成するとともに、大学院共通科目の担当教員および開講事務局に連絡を取り、単位認定の許可をいただきながら事務的な手続きを進め、TWINSの履修登録および成績入力まで行いました。

また、記念品については、実行委員の先生方、サポートチームの方々にご意見をいただきながら、学生委員とともにホスト校である中国地質大学等（中国）の教員委員・学生委員への記念品を選出・発注し、現地での大学間交流に役立てていただきました。細かい確認や調整事項について、その都度、サポートチームや先生方、学生委員と情報を共有し、連携して進めることで円滑に業務を遂行することができました。

2.2 連絡調整・スケジュール管理（佐藤 昌敦）

サポートチームのリーダーとして、教職員および学生委員の連絡調整を担当するとともに、全体の進捗管理を行いました。また、中国側の事情で非常に難航していた留学生のビザ取得をエリアコモンズ 小林主任および国際連携コーディネーター

渋谷さんとともにサポートしました。ほか、来年度フォーラムが本学で開催されることを受けて、その運営を担当することになる支援室 URA の方々と受入れ人数や予算等の実施体制をあらかじめ検討しました。

様々な相談事等に対応してくださった世話人教員の楊教授をはじめとした教職員の方々、また例年より少ない人数で学生対応を一手に引き受けてくださった学生委員の皆さまに、この場を借りて御礼申し上げます。

2.3 会計処理・予算管理・バス、航空券の手配（高谷 創）

支出に関連すること全般について、本学規則に則りつつ、支出計画のアドバイスおよび支払処理を行いました。今年度は例年に比べて本学からの参加者が多く、航空券を確保するために見積競争を行うなど、普段あまり関わりのない業務に携わり貴重な経験になりました。元より、普段財務関係の仕事をしていると、大学の教育関連に携わる機会が皆無です。今回のようなサポートの機会は全学的に見ても生命環境エリア支援室独自の取組であることから、非常に貴重な体験が出来たと思っています。来年度は本学で開催しますので、日中韓大学院生フォーラムが更に盛り上がっていただけるよう、サポートできればと考えています。

2.4 予算申請・出張手続き・フォーラム随行（吉田 将吾）

グローバル・コモンズ連携プログラムおよび平成 29 年度はばたけ！筑大生への申請書作成および学生・教職員の出張手続きを担当しました。また、フォーラムに随行し、実際にフォーラムで活躍する本学の学生を見ることができました。本フォーラムがプレゼンテーションスキルだけでなく、国際交流の場として学生を成長させることができ、今後もこの日中韓フォーラムを事務側でもよりよいものにしていきたいと思いました。

普段接する機会の少ない支援室メンバーと協力し合って本フォーラムを成功させることができたことは事務職員としての自信にもつながったと思います。関係者の皆様には心から感謝申し上げます。
